


## Input file example

Drawj2d input files are UTF-8 encoded text files. Any editor does the job to write or modify these files. Consider using jEdit ([www.jedit.org](http://www.jedit.org)), it provides syntax highlighting for Drawj2d commands. The drawing units are mm, unless specified differently using the command `unitlength`. The program documentation covers all the commands available for Drawj2d and provides examples.

To preview the output of this file, run `"drawj2d -Tscreen example.hcl"`, to generate a pdf run `"drawj2d -Tpdf example.hcl"`.
